LANG 1010 [0.5 credit]

Introduction to a Language I

Introductory study of a selected language. Oral skills; basic reading and writing skills. The language taught will vary from year to year. Compulsory attendance. Four hours a week.

LANG 1020 [0.5 credit]

Introduction to a Language II

Continuation of LANG 1010. Oral skills; basic reading and writing skills. Compulsory attendance. Prerequisite(s): grade of C or higher in LANG 1010, or permission of the School. Four hours a week.

LANG 1110 [1.0 credit]

Intensive Introduction to a Language

Introductory study of a selected language. Oral skills; basic reading and writing skills. The language taught will vary from year to year. Compulsory attendance. Eight hours a week (one term).

LANG 2010 [0.5 credit]

Second-Year Language I

Further study of a selected language to reach a more advanced level of proficiency in a range of situations. Equal emphasis on oral and written language. Compulsory attendance. Precludes additional credit for LANG 2110, when taken in the same language. Prerequisite(s): grade of C or higher in LANG 1020 or LANG 1110, or permission of the School. Four hours a week.

LANG 2020 [0.5 credit]

Second-Year Language II

Continuation of second-year of a selected language. Further study of this language to reach a more advanced level of proficiency in a range of situations. Equal emphasis on oral and written language. Compulsory attendance. Precludes additional credit for LANG 2110, when taken in the same language. Prerequisite(s): grade of C or higher in LANG 2010 or permission of the School. Four hours a week.

LANG 2110 [1.0 credit]

Continuing Intensive Study of a Language

Further study of a selected language to reach a more advanced level of proficiency in a range of situations. Equal emphasis on oral and written language. The language taught will vary from year to year. Compulsory attendance.

Prerequisite(s): grade of C or higher in LANG 1020 or LANG 1110 or permission of the School. Eight hours a week (one term).

Summer session: some of the courses listed in this Calendar are offered during the summer. Hours and scheduling for summer session courses will differ significantly from those reported in the fall/winter Calendar.
