

# Academic Regulations for Certificate Students

---

## **7.1 Academic Regulations and Requirements for Undergraduate Certificates**

In addition to the requirements presented here, students must satisfy the university regulations (see the Academic Regulations of the University section of this Calendar).

### **Definition**

An undergraduate certificate is defined as a structured set of at least 4.0 undergraduate credits in a particular discipline or area of study that introduces the student to - or extends their knowledge of - that discipline or area of study. An undergraduate certificate is a stand-alone credential that may be taken concurrently with a bachelor's program or independently. It is normally constituted by a structured set of sequential year-level courses.

### **Program Requirements**

- A minimum of 4.0 credits
- Minimum grade requirements may apply
